The Police Department has created its own Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) Drone Program. The program is supported by a generous donation from the Salwen Family.

Two police officers have been trained on the utilization of the UAS drone and have completed their FAA Part 107 pilots' certification.

The mission of the Lower Gwynedd Police UAS Drone Program is to provide airborne support to police and emergency operations in a safe, responsible, and transparent manner, for the purpose of increasing the safety and security of citizens.
