This is a new position created to implement a formal fire inspection program within the Township. This is a great opportunity for someone who likes to learn, enjoys working with people, and wants to contribute to public safety.

The Fire Inspector is a technical public safety officer position who will operate under the supervision of the Fire Marshal to conduct fire and life-safety inspections of non-residential buildings throughout Lower Gwynedd Township. The overall purpose of these inspections is to confirm that the building and its operations comply with the International Fire Code 2018, as well as other Township Codes, to ensure that the safety of the occupants is maintained. This individual will perform inspections, verify compliance, identify potential fire hazards, prepare inspection reports, compile corrective actions for fire and life-safety violations, conduct follow-up inspections, and input all information into the Township database.

The desired applicant will have a minimum of five (5) years of fire/emergency management service experience. Fire prevention/inspection training from accredited fire training facilities is required and must include Pennsylvania Fire Inspector I & II. Certifications should be included in the application submission. A valid Pennsylvania driver's license Class-C is required. Any combination of education, training, and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities will be considered. The salary range for this position is \$30-\$40/hour dependent upon qualifications.
