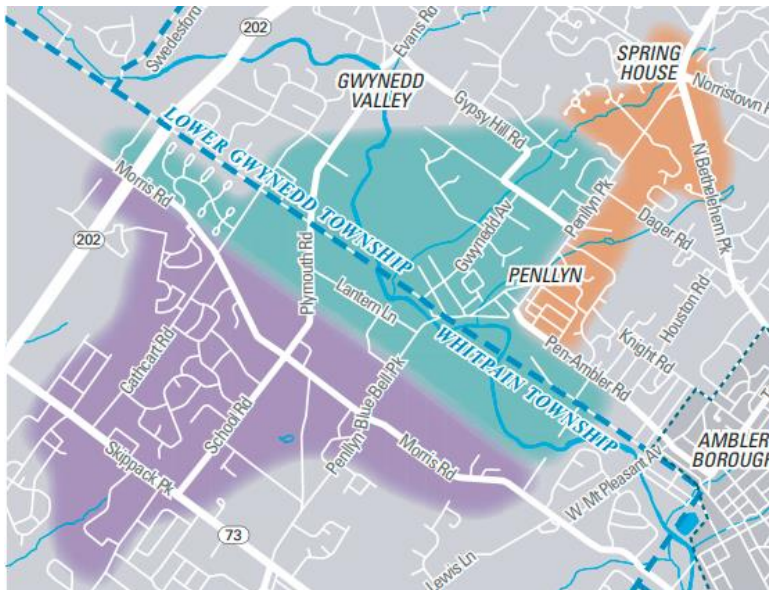

Dear Customer,

PECO is currently upgrading the electric distribution system in Lower Gwynedd Township and Whitpain Township. The project is part of an ongoing infrastructure investment in the local energy grid to help prevent outages, modernize service, and reduce the impact of extreme weather on electric infrastructure.

The map shows the project area and work locations. Color-coded markers indicate the type, timing, and status of work in each location, if it is currently in progress, scheduled in the near term, or planned for a future phase.



 Electric construction work in Lower Gwynedd Township and Whitpain townships is underway and is expected to be complete by late fall 2026. Qualified PECO contractor Empower, will be performing the work on behalf of PECO.

 Based on recent vegetation survey work, tree trimming and removals in Lower Gwynedd Township is underway. This upcoming vegetation work may require clearly marked lane

closures or detours following state and local regulations. Access for trash removal and emergency vehicles will be maintained. Following the completion of vegetation work in Lower Gwynedd Township, electric construction work is expected to begin by qualified PECO contractor Miller Brothers. This work is expected to be completed by late winter 2027.

 In 2027, electric construction work in Whitpain Township will begin and be performed by qualified PECO contractor Carr & Duff.

We are committed to keeping you informed throughout this project and to minimizing impacts wherever possible. We have carefully developed a plan to complete this project work in a safe and timely manner.
